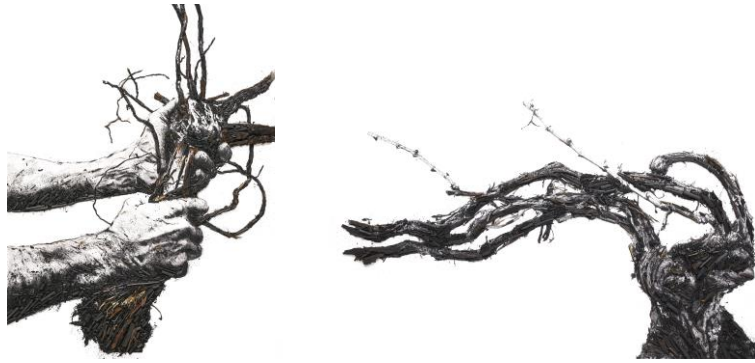


Le Royal Monceau – Raffles Paris presents « Serra »,
An ephemeral private dining room, designed by Maison Ruinart,
From the 4th to the 16th of November 2019



This autumn, Le Royal Monceau - Raffles Paris invites Ruinart to establish its private dining room in the restaurant Il Carpaccio for 2 weeks, from the 4th to the 16th of November 2019. The universe of this exclusive space, with a capacity of 10 seats, will be entirely designed around an artistic collaboration between the Brazilian artist Vik Muniz and Maison Ruinart. The "Shared Roots" champagne pairing menu will be available for lunch and dinner.

From São Paolo to New York, Vik Muniz's itinerary is like his art: breathtaking. Fascinated by the power of image and optics, he specialises in the reproduction of masterpieces and photographs through unusual raw materials such as: foliage, flowers, rubbish. The artist seeks to awaken the spectator's senses, for a complete immersion in his universe.

During the 2018 harvest in Reims, Vik Muniz discovered the historical vineyard of the oldest Champagne Maison: Ruinart. There, he met the Cellar Master Frédéric Panaïotis, with whom he shared a sincere passion for nature. From this beautiful collaboration will emerge seven works on the theme of roots, including a scenography to be discovered during the two weeks of the event, in the heart of the lobby of Le Royal Monceau - Raffles Paris.

Chef Filipe Da Assunção, "Meilleur ouvrier de France", will compose a unique menu, sublimating various root vegetables, from the most common to the most unusual ones. On his side, Pierre Hermé will imagine an exquisite pastry with subtle notes, while Frédéric Panaïotis will propose a dedicated food and champagne pairing.

This "Serra" table, combining the art of Vik Muniz, the know-how of Ruinart and the excellence of Le Royal Monceau - Raffles Paris, will be open for lunch and dinner. The promise of a sensory and artistic experience.
