Shoreditch

2nd-7th June 2025

This year’s theme ‘Surface Reflections’ by Artistic Director Dr Samuel Ross MBE, Founder of A COLD-WALL*, explores how ideas are fuelled by both our internal experiences and external influences.

Trooping The Colour

Horse Guards Parade

14th June 2025

Trooping The Colour has marked the official birthday of the British Sovereign for over 260 years. Over 1400 parading soldiers, 200 horses and 400 musicians come together each June in a great display of military precision, horsemanship and fanfare. The King's Colour of 2nd Battalion Coldstream Guards will be trooped by Number 7 Company Coldstream Guards to mark the Sovereign's official birthday.

Djokovic has proven himself to be a reliable presence on the Wimbledon stage, having emerged victorious several times. Siena: The Rise of Painting, 1300-1350

National Gallery
until 22nd June 2025

Step into Siena. It's the beginning of the 14th century in central Italy. A golden moment for art, a catalyst of change. Artists Duccio, Simone Martini and the brothers Pietro and Ambrogio Lorenzetti are forging a new way of painting. They paint with a drama that no one has seen before. Faces show emotion. Bodies move in space. Stories flow across panels in colourful scenes.

Yoshitomo Nara

Dive into the captivating, creative world of Yoshitomo Nara in the largest European retrospective of one of Japan's most celebrated artists. José María Velasco - A View of Mexico

He was fascinated by advances in geology, the archaeology of his home country, the study of local flora, and the increasing presence of industrialisation.

Ed Atkins

Tate Britain
Until 25th August 2025

Ed Atkins is best known for his computer-generated videos and animations. Repurposing contemporary technologies in unexpected ways, his work traces the dwindling gap between the digital world and human feeling. He borrows techniques from literature, video games, music and theatre to examine the relationship between reality, realism and fiction.

Kiefer / Van Gogh

Royal Academy
Opens 28th June 2025

Vincent van Gogh has had an enduring influence on Anselm Kiefer. See work by both artists side by side this summer. In 1890 Vincent van Gogh painted his final works. Seventy-two years later an eighteen-year-old Anselm Kiefer received a travel grant to follow in the footsteps of Van Gogh, starting in the Netherlands, through to Belgium, Paris and Arles in the south of France. This focused exhibition, set across the three rooms of the RA's smaller galleries, is the first to consider the lasting influence that Van Gogh has had on Kiefer.

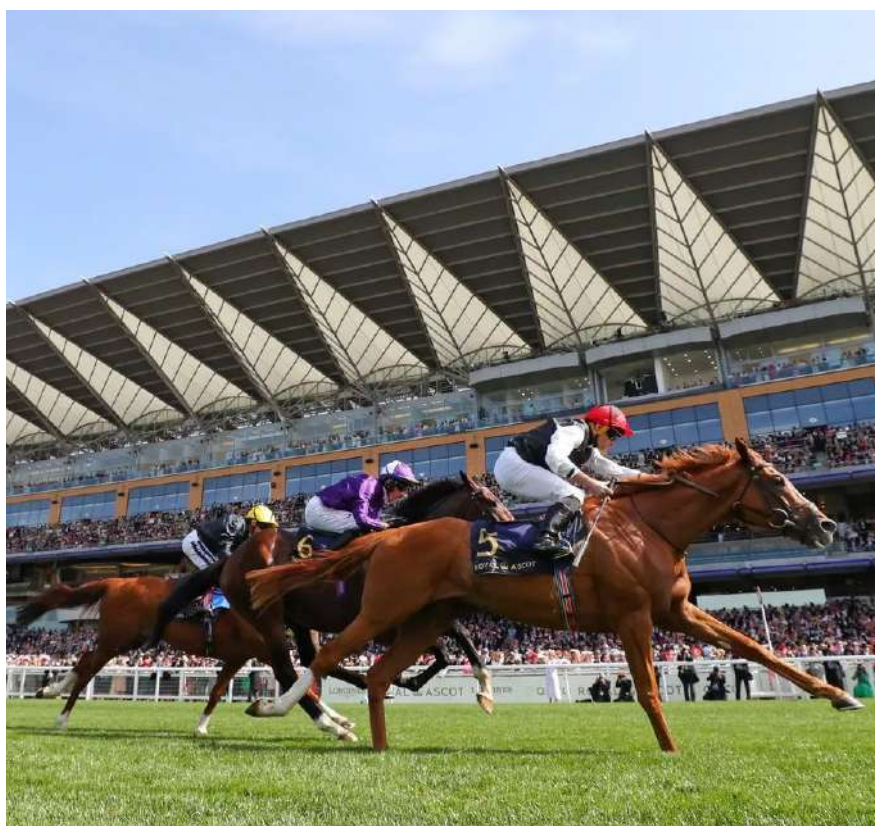

Despite the controversy that surrounded Michael Jackson's life, it cannot be denied that his influence on the music industry was massive. And it is his musicianship that is celebrated in this Tony award-winning production, which focuses on preparations for his 'Dangerous World Tour'. The West End is fortunate indeed to be able to see such a talented performer portraying Jackson. His dancing is quite phenomenal, and the 'Thriller' sequence is one of the best showstoppers in London at the moment.

The show envelops you from the moment you're offered a schnapps on the way to your seat! This is an inventive, intriguing, sexy new version of the decadent musical. Exhilarating from start to finish, it's a must-see. You really do feel like you're in a nightclub, surrounded by captivating performers. There's a sense of confrontation and mischief about the whole thing, as events in the pre-war Berlin bar track Germany's descent into darkness. Astounding. It now stars Billy Porter (from 'Pose') and Marisha Wallace (the best of the 'Dreamgirls').

Zibi Kedziora

As part of our role, we make it a point to explore and experience the best restaurants across London. We try and test them ourselves to ensure we're offering guests the finest recommendations. This month's pick comes from Zibi.

Nestled just a short 3-minute walk from The Savoy, Osteria Del Mare is Bocconcino's newest seafood restaurant and a true gem for lovers of Italian cuisine with a seafood twist. The cosy, stylish interior immediately sets the tone for an intimate yet vibrant dining experience. With its proximity to the theatre district, it's the perfect spot for a pre-theatre meal, offering a relaxed atmosphere where you can savour each course at your own pace.

Our meal began with the Salmon Avocado Tartare, a refreshing and delicate combination of silky smooth avocado and fresh, perfectly seasoned salmon. Next, the Tomato Gazpacho with Prawns & Feta arrived. It's chilled, vibrant red hue and refreshing taste provided the perfect balance to the richness of the preceding dishes.

For the main course, we couldn't resist trying the Pizza Tonno Cipolla. The crispy, thin crust was topped generously with fresh, tender tuna and sweet caramelised onions, a simple yet flavourful combination that proved to be a crowd favourite. The Octopus Confit with Potatoes & Cavolo Nero was another standout. The octopus was perfectly tender and complemented by the earthy bitterness of the cavolo nero and the comforting texture of the potatoes.

To end on a sweet note, we were treated to an amazing and generous portion of Pistachio Tiramisu, which was decadently creamy and nutty, offering a delightful twist on the classic dessert. To cleanse the palate, the Amalfi Lemon Sorbet was a refreshing, citrusy finish that was both tart and sweet.

Whether you're looking for a pre-theatre dinner or a leisurely weekend brunch, Osteria Del Mare delivers impeccable Italian cuisine in a warm and inviting atmosphere.

Please note on this tour, your guide will not be permitted to guide inside the castle itself, but will give you a thorough exterior tour before you enter and will share with you stories of the staff that maintain the castle, their relationship with the Royals, and provide you with a rich insight into the impact of Royalty on our national psyche. You will see the chapel (the location of the recent Royal weddings) and the late Queen's final resting place.

You then have two options for your day:

Option 1 - Traditional Afternoon Tea

Your guide will join you and explain the history of the tea, the origin of the famous sandwiches, the correct etiquette and an understanding of how to win any future "milk before or after" debate. Depending on availability, we will either take you to Cliveden House or the Fairmont Windsor.

Option 2 – Private River Cruise down the Thames

Instead of afternoon tea, after a traditional pub lunch we could take you down to Windsor Promenade to board your private vessel for an hour river cruise down to Boveney Lock and back. Glide along the iconic River Thames, taking in panoramic views of Windsor's majestic castle, the charming riverside homes, and lush greenery that line the banks.
